Letter from the Chair

James Kirkpatrick, MD, FASE, 2022 – 2024 ASE Foundation Board Chair & Annual Appeal Committee Chair



Happy New Year! I hope 2023 is treating you very well so far. I feel optimistic about what the ASE Foundation will accomplish this year, given our incredibly successful 2022 Annual Appeal. It gives me such joy to share that because of you, the Foundation exceeded its goal to raise \$225,000 by raising over \$266,000! Before I share what I'm looking forward to this year, let's take a look at a few notable accomplishments last year:

- Awarded 46 travel grants to students, sonographers, and fellows.
- Raised \$5,126 from the signed textbook auction. Thank you, Raymond Stainback, MD, FASE for donating the books.
- Fully funded the Pamela S. Douglas, MD, FASE Research Scholar Endowment.
- Raised \$46,112 for research from the 13th Annual Research Awards Gala.
- Hit a new fundraising record for GivingTuesday, raising \$37,559.
- Began planning global health outreach events for 2023 and forward.
- Raised \$37,395 to establish the Gregory Tatum Global Health Travel Grant Endowment.

Thank you again to the more than 2,500 people who donated in 2022. Your donations will allow us to do even more this year!

Looking ahead, I am very happy that the Foundation is resuming it's in-person global health outreach events! Our next event will take place this September in the Sapa region of northeastern Vietnam and will involve a research project, training of physician and non-physician sonographers, and lectures and hands-on training at the Vietnam National Heart Institute in Hanoi. This outreach event will be dedicated to the memory of Gregory H. Tatum, MD, FASE who, tragically, died last November. Donations made in his memory funded the Gregory Tatum Global Health Travel Grant Endowment which will be used to fund a long-term series of travel grants for volunteers participating in global health activities, allowing many ASE professionals the opportunity to follow in Greg's footsteps.

We are also working on a donation competition in March, a little "ASEF March Games" if you will. Participating ASE members groups have been invited to compete against one

another to kick off our 2023 Annual Appeal fundraising! I hope this competition attracts attention from a broader section of ASE members and spreads the word about the Foundation, in addition to allowing us all to engage in friendly rivalry.

This June, the Scientific Sessions will be in National Harbor, MD, and I have the privilege of being the Program Chair. The Program Committee and I are hard at work planning a fantastic meeting in this amazing setting. National Harbor has become a "destination" for the mid-Atlantic, with incredible restaurants, amazing shopping, summer activities for kids (including live outdoor bands and movies), a water taxi to Alexandria, VA, and so much more! Make sure you stop by the Foundation's booth to say hello to staff, track your steps for the Cardiovascular Challenge, check out photos from prior year *Images from the Heart* Exhibits, and make a donation. You'll also want to pack your dancing shoes because the 14th Annual Research Awards Gala will take place Sunday, June 25 from 6:30 pm – 11:00 pm. The theme is "All the Colors of the World", and attendees are invited to dress in formal attire showcasing their personal heritage and culture. Your 2022 donations will allow ASEF to fund numerous travel grants for sonography students, abstract presenters, and subspecialty trainees to support their attendance at the meeting. I am looking forward to all of this and continuing to work with our volunteers and Foundation staff. With the continued support of our donors, I know we will continue to make a world of difference.

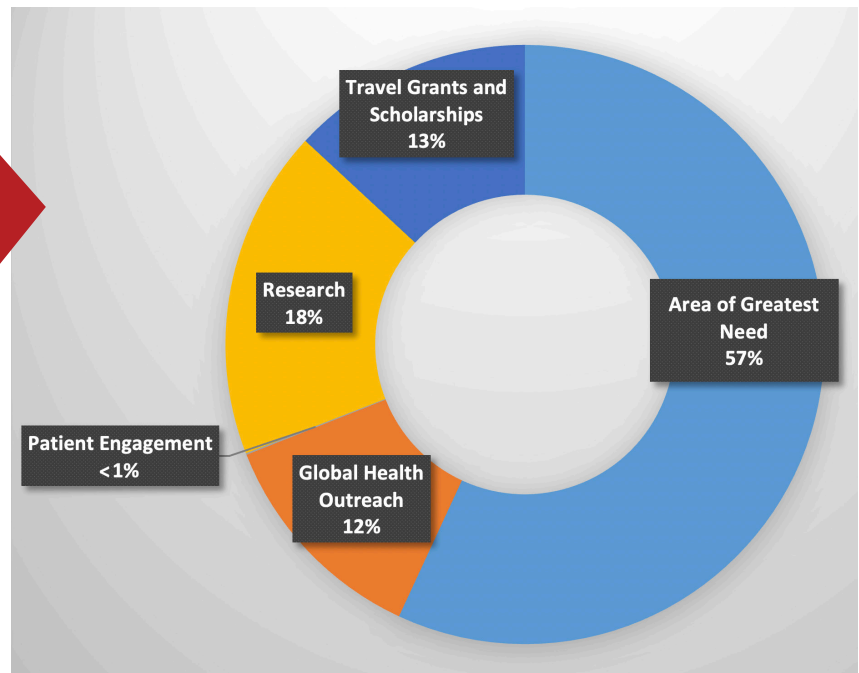

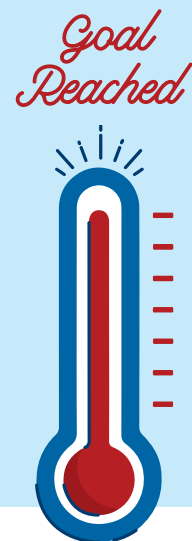
