Program Director nominations for the 2025 <u>Alan D. Waggoner Sonographer Student</u> <u>Scholarship Awards</u> are open until this Friday, November 15. Established in 2001 in recognition of Mr. Waggoner's professional achievements and service to ASE, these awards include a \$1,000 USD scholarship, complimentary registration for ASE's Annual Scientific Sessions, and a \$1,000 USD travel grant to attend the meeting. The Katanick Student Scholarship Award, established in honor of Sandy Katanick, RN, RVT, CAE, for her over 25 years of service as CEO of the Intersocietal Accreditation Commission, recognizes the highest-ranking Waggoner scholarship applicant.
